



CAMP SOONER 2012 - Sponsors

We are very thankful that you are considering attending Camp Sooner as an adult sponsor. We cannot stress how important we feel camp is to kids. There are so many aspects of fundamental growth that you get at church camp that you can't get anywhere else. We feel that our adults are a core part of what makes church camp function properly. Without you, we would have a hard pressed time having the supervision for the kids that would be needed.

We hope that you take a few minutes to talk to your youth or children's minister to find out what he or she will be expecting of you as a sponsor for your church. It is important that you understand that while you may be attending camp as a parent to your camper, you will also be here as camp support. You will be expected to help out in various capacities including, but not limited to family group leader, food service, cleaning, cabin oversight, and counselor. We would like for you to know that while we want your experience at Camp Sooner to be a fulfillment for you yourself, that you are here first and foremost for the campers.

What to Bring or Not

The most important and most often neglected thing that we ask of you is to observe the guidelines of what to bring to camp (and what to leave home). The first thing that we ask our campers to leave home (and, yes, we know this is hard) is their cell phone. We are not requiring this of adults, but we would encourage you to limit your cell usage while here for the sake of fairness and as an example to the campers (the same thing goes for laptops). Our cell phone policy for campers will be strict this year—if cell phones are brought to camp, they will be taken at the beginning of the week and will not be returned until after prayer circle on the final day. Other things we ask you to leave at home are electronic devices (includes cd players, radios, iPods, MP3 players, Blackberries, etc), fireworks, and items of value (like expensive clothes or irreplaceable items). Bringing any drugs, alcohol or any tobacco product is forbidden and doing so will result in your being sent home immediately.

You may be asking yourself what DO I need to bring to camp. Here's a good list:

- Clothes & extra shoes (include clothes to play in, get dirty in, and swimwear)
- Towels/washcloths for showers and/or swimming
- Twin sized bedding or sleeping bag & a pillow
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, etc)
- Extra Money for canteen and missions
- Bible, pens, paper/note pads, etc
- **Any medication that you take regularly, labeled with dosage & intervals in a Ziploc bag.**
- Flashlight
- Sunscreen & Bug spray
- Optional Items: Flashlight, extension cord/power strip, camera, goggles, sports equipment (like shoes, gloves, bats, braces, etc).

Your Recommendation

Your youth minister, children's minister or senior minister **MUST** sign your registration form acknowledging that you are approved to be a sponsor for your church. Any adult that does not have this signature will **NOT** be allowed to serve at Camp Sooner. This is for the safety of our campers. **We also reserve the right to run formal background checks on any sponsor requesting to attend Camp Sooner.** If you know of any reasons why your check may come up negative, please include that information on the appropriate place on your registration form.
