

CAMP SOONER CAMPER INFORMATION

All you need to know about packing for camp!

What to bring:

- ?? Clothes & extra shoes (Include clothes to play in, get dirty in, and swimwear. Don't forget shoes to wear to the pool or bath houses and an extra pair of shoes in case of rain.)
- ?? Bedding & Towels
 - Sheets and blanket or sleeping bag and a pillow
 - Towel(s) for showers and/or swimming
- ?? Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, etc)
- ?? Extra Money
 - Missions
 - Canteen
 - Camp Bookstore (New this year for Jr/Sr High weeks of camp! The camp will be having a bookstore for campers to buy books, cds, and other items.)
- ?? Bible, pens, paper/note pads, journals, prayer journals, etc.
- ?? Any medication that you take regularly
- ?? Optional Items
 - Flashlight
 - Extension cord(s)/power strip
 - Camera
 - Sunscreen
 - Bug Spray
 - Sports equipment (like shoes, gloves, bats, braces, etc—make sure you write your name on anything you bring)

What NOT to bring:

- ?? Electronic devices (includes tape/CD players, radios, DVD players, I-Pods, MP3 players, laptops, TVs, Blackberries, etc.). You may bring a cell phone, but it is to remain in your cabin at all times., and your youth minister/sponsor has the right to dictate when/if you may use it.
- ?? Drugs, alcohol, cigarettes, etc (bringing these will result in your being sent home immediately at your own expense)
- ?? Fireworks
- ?? Items of value
 - Expensive clothes (camp can be messy!)
 - Irreplaceable Items (like your 100 year old family Bible)

Dress Code:

- ?? Modesty will prevail in all matters—any adult has the right to ask you to change your clothes.
- ?? **Ladies:** No Tank tops, no shirts that do NOT cover your stomach completely. Remember our check rule: Raise your arms above your head and then make sure that your stomach is covered. All shorts must be at mid thigh. Please try and wear tops that are your size, not too tight. No two piece swimsuits—if you have one, it must be covered by a dark T-shirt (not tank top). No tank tops or spaghetti strap shirts.
- ?? **Guys:** No sagging pants. No exposed boxers. No tank tops (but sleeveless shirts are okay), no tight shirts. You will not be allowed to go shirtless while playing sports, so plan accordingly.
